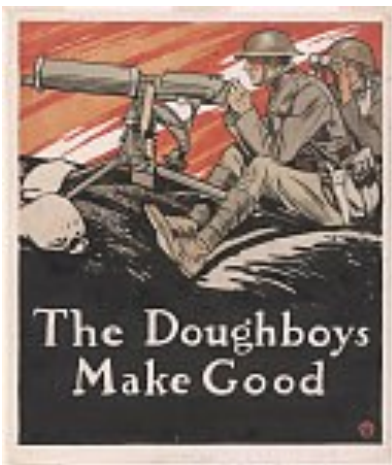

Clarence A. Deppen was John's paternal grandfather. Though he died long before John was born, he left behind an impressive record of military and public service. Deppen was a lifelong resident of Northumberland County and was elected to four terms as Sunbury's City Controller.

Through personal letters, military records, and other research, John has re-constructed a worthy program about WWI and Deppen's military journey. The story of our Doughboys deserves to be told, especially with the installation of an incredible new sculpture at the National World War I Memorial planned for September of this year.
